



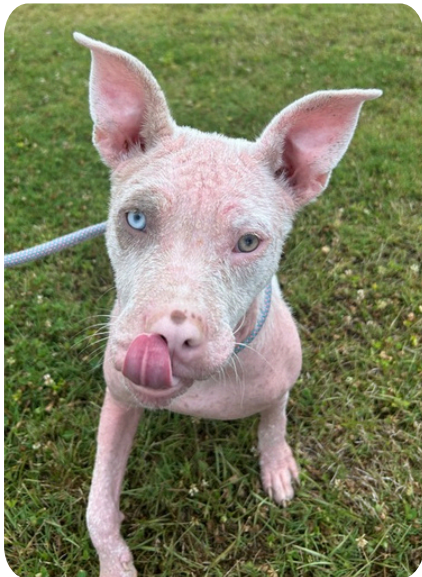
ANYTHING IS PAWSIBLE
